The Occupational English Test (OET GCC) is a specialised English language proficiency test designed for healthcare professionals who wish to work or obtain professional registration in GCC countries. A

Consultation Notes

Listen to two real professional–patient consultations and accurately record key clinical information, including symptoms, treatment details, and care plans.

B

Short Workplace Extracts

Six brief workplace conversations, testing your understanding of ideas, details, and speaker intent through MCQs.

C

Presentations or Interviews

Two extended recordings on professional healthcare topics, assessing your ability to follow detailed discussions and understand key points through multiple-choice questions.

OET Listening test format

The OET Listening section is approximately 40 minutes long and comprises 42 questions across three parts: consultations, workplace dialogues, and presentations. Test-takers listen to recordings of healthcare scenarios and answer questions to demonstrate their ability to comprehend spoken English in various medical contexts.

Tackling the OET Listening Section

WHAT YOU'LL DO

The OET Listening section checks how well you understand spoken English in healthcare environments. You will hear recordings based on real situations such as patient consultations, workplace conversations, and professional presentations, and answer questions based on what you hear.

TIPS TO SUCCEED

Improve your listening by regularly hearing healthcare-related audio like medical talks, training videos, or podcasts. Practice picking out key points, important details, and the main message. Pay attention to different accents and speaking styles to build confidence in understanding real-world medical communication.



Preparing effectively for the OET exam can significantly enhance your performance.

Here are a few tips to help you practise for the test:

Practice regularly



Utilise OET sample tests and mock exams to familiarise yourself with the format and timing of each section. Regular practice will help you become comfortable with the exam structure and improve your performance.

Focus on medical vocabulary



Enhance your medical vocabulary and terminology relevant to your profession to improve comprehension and communication skills. Practice using specialised medical terms in context to ensure clarity and precision in your communication during the exam.

Work on your general English proficiency



On top of improving your medical vocabulary and terminology, be sure to improve your general English communication skills as well. Reading or listening to medical and healthcare-related texts, videos, or even podcasts will help you better understand how to communicate effectively in a range of situations.

Familiarise yourself with the OET assessment criteria



Each OET sub-test is assessed and marked according to their own criteria. Understanding what this criteria entails will allow you to identify your weaknesses or blind spots and recognise what steps you need to take to improve your score.

Time management



Practice under timed conditions to ensure you complete each section within the allocated time. As you get closer to your OET test date, sit for mock full-length tests to emulate the test conditions exactly. Effective time management is crucial for maximising your performance on exam day.
